November is the month of Thanksgiving.


At Oak Park-Carpenter we are truly thankful for our families and every part of our school community that makes this a warm, caring environment for all our students to gather, learn, and be together.

Illness/Covid - When to Keep Your Child Home

- Temperature of 100 degrees or higher
- Sore throat, headache, fatigue
- Congestion, runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

- Undiagnosed rash or skin lesions
- Red or discharging eyes
